

INFORMED CONSENT FORM

TEEN LOCK-IN EVENT

My child, _____ (please print teen's name), is registering to participate in the Teen Lock-In on Friday, July 13, 2018, at the Marshall-Lyon County Library. I understand that the Lock-In will begin at 7:00 pm July 13, and will end at 7:00 am on Saturday, July 14, and that my child is required to remain at the library during this entire time, unless I personally pick up my child from the building. If my child leaves the library for any reason and at any time during this event, library staff will immediately notify me.

I and my child also understand that my child shares responsibility for safety in the program. My child agrees to comply with the instructions and directions of the Marshall-Lyon County Library staff members and other adults during the event. If my child chooses not to comply, library staff will notify me. I will then be expected to come and pick up my child from the library within a reasonable amount of time.

I understand that snacks, beverages, and a light breakfast will be provided, but that the library cannot accommodate for dietary restrictions. My child may bring snacks, but not beverages, to the event.

I am aware that my child will be using craft supplies that may stain clothing and should dress accordingly.

I hereby release the Marshall-Lyon County Library from any and all liabilities to my child with respect to injury, sickness, loss, or damage. I also consent for my child to receive medical treatment, which may be deemed advisable in the event of an injury, accident, or illness during this program.

Additionally, I hereby authorize and give my full consent to the Marshall-Lyon County Library, to copyright or publish all photographs in which my child appears while participating in this event. For their exclusive use the Marshall-Lyon County Library may transfer, use, or cause to be used, these photographs for any and all exhibitions, public displays, publications, commercials, art, and advertising purposes.
